From the M25 at Junction 26 follow signs to Loughton A121 onto Honey Lane (A121). Honey Lane becomes Woodricken Hill (A121). At next roundabout take 3rd exit onto Goldings Hill (A121), signposted Loughton. At double mini- roundabout turn left onto Rectory Lane (A1168), signposted Chigwell (M11). Turn right at roundabout onto Borders Lane. The Willingale Place development is on the right, opposite Deepdean Road.

Willingale Place Surrounding Area

The overwhelming impression that people take away from their first visit to Loughton is of its abundance of greenery. At 1,500 acres, the Epping Forest dominates a region that also has around 600 acres of green- belt meadows and wetlands and more than its fair share of excellent golf courses. If you are new to the area, you will quickly understand how it came to be known as the lungs of North East London.

Dotted with historic buildings, Loughton's centre boasts a wide variety of shops, from high street names to one- off boutiques, together with bars and restaurants catering for all tastes.

Should you feel the need to put your spare time to more productive use, the town also has a library, sports centre and lots of other fitness amenities such as the famous Epping Forest Country Club. Local schools also enjoy an excellent reputation and, together with the wide range of local facilities, have attracted many young families to the area.

If you have to leave, excellent transport facilities make the journey remarkably smooth. The M11 is close by with its fast links to Central London (15 miles), Cambridge and Newmarket, while the nearby M25 puts the whole of the South East within easy reach.

If you prefer to travel by tube, the Central Line speeds you directly into the heart of London from Loughton's Underground Station- the area has long been popular with City workers who want to be able to enjoy the countryside but also get to their desks in Liverpool Street in under an hour.*

Put simply, Loughton is ideal for those who want to get away from it all, but don't want to go too far to get there. Opening hours: Thursdays to Mondays 10am till 5.30pm and 11am till 5pm Sundays.


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
